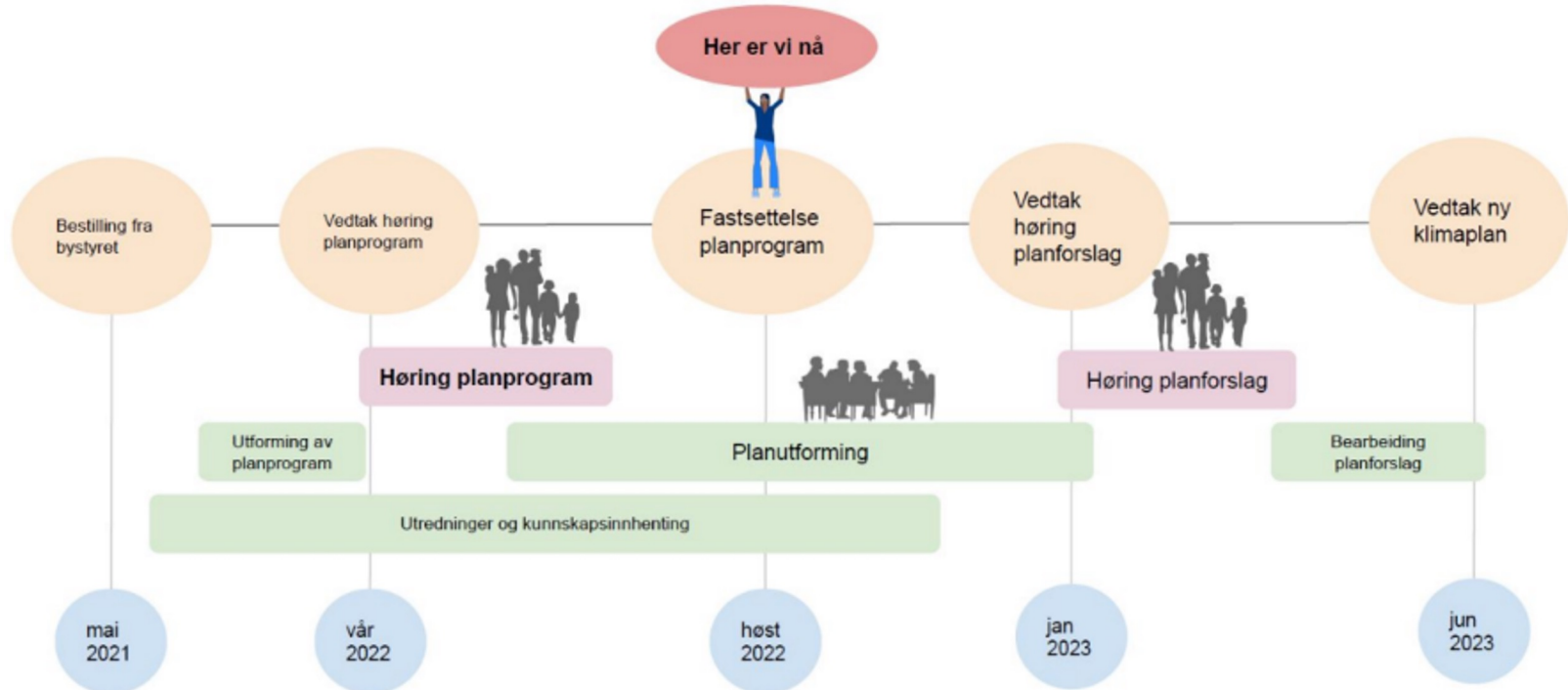

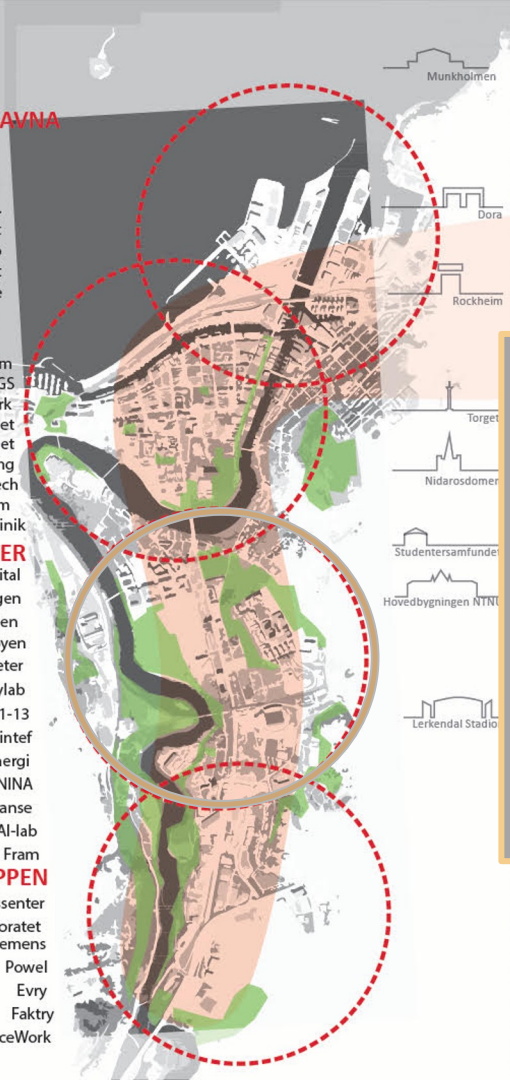

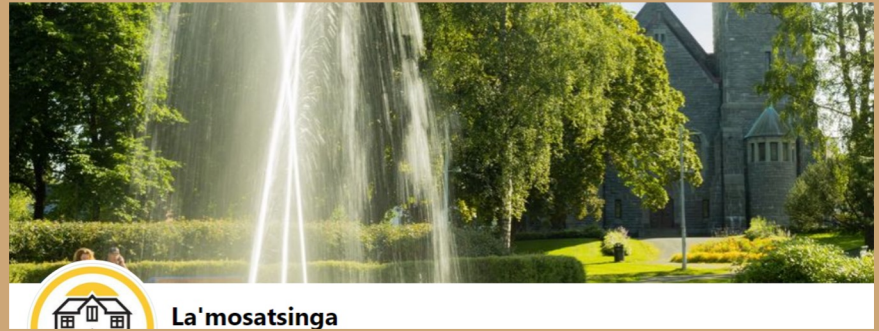
Area investments in Trondheim

In 2021, the Saupstad-Kolstad area development (Områdeløft) was completed and two new area initiatives were established for Lademoen and Tempe-Sorgenfri.

Area-oriented efforts are a means of improving the environment and living conditions in a geographically defined area. A collaboration between the state, municipality and local community.

Methodology:

- Strengthening an area's own resources by seeing services, resources, social and physical conditions in context.
- Local anchoring is a prerequisite for success with area-oriented efforts; facilitating local participation in development and implementation is a cornerstone of the methodology.

- Establish good urban spaces for the community

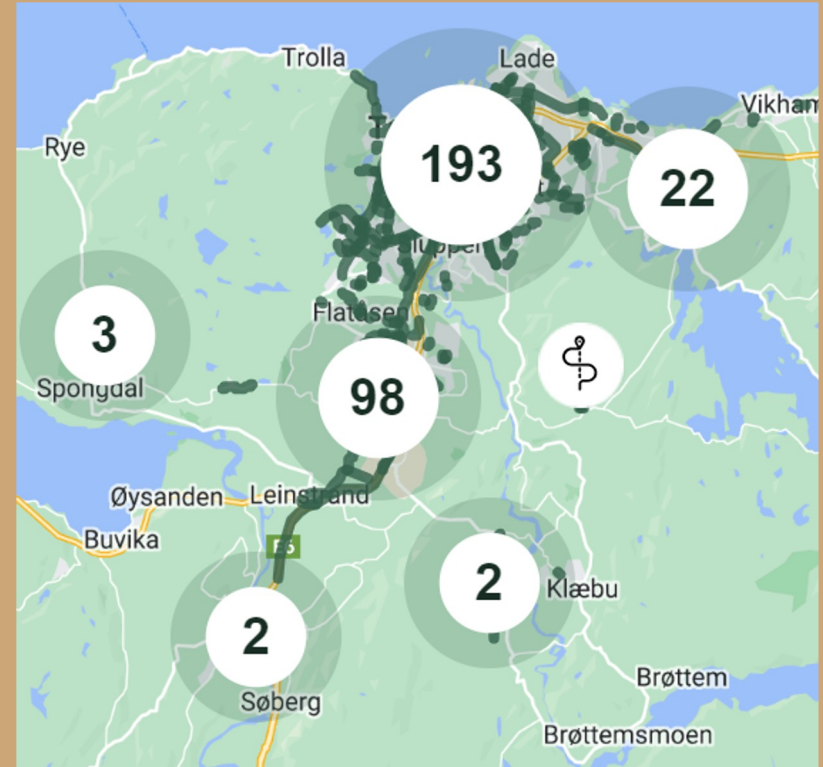
